Local safety organizations need the majority of businesses that own and use lift trucks to ensure that all forklift operators are trained. Companies can face penalties and fines for failing to properly train all forklift operators.

Forklift training and certification which is provided by the employers is typically facilitated by an on-site manager. Programs would often consist of safety measures, instruction on the lift truck and its parts and the proper operation of the forklift. Testing would be performed to assess comprehension. A test of performance happens at the end of the program. If successful, the trainee will receive a certification card.

An alternative to employer-provided training involves enrolling in a course at a forklift certification or industrial equipment training school. Trainees receive practical instruction on different kinds of forklifts. Safety measures are a major focus of the training. A written test and driving test should be successfully carried out before a lift truck certification card is given. The lift truck certification designation can be transferred to work performed on a lift truck with any employer, which makes it convenient for people looking for a forklift operator job.

If the forklift is utilized improperly; the results might bring about injury to the worker, other employees, and to company property. Supervisors have to make sure that all relevant employees get certified so as to prevent workplace accidents. Forklift certification is usually valid for two or three years, after which re-certification is needed.
